





6. 硬體安裝完成。開啟電源後請透過作業系統進行後續格式化設定。請依照電腦作業系統指示進行 硬碟格式化,完成硬碟格式化後,便可以進行資料的讀寫。



RAID 模式切換設定



RAID 0: 一個大的獨立資料儲存容量,並可加速資料存取但無資料保護功能。

RAID 1:兩顆硬碟是鏡射關係因此擁有相同的資料,因此有一顆硬碟損毀仍然可以正常運作。 當放入新硬碟取代損毀硬碟後,系統會自動將資料重建到新的硬碟。

JBOD : 可對兩顆獨立硬碟進行管理的工作,能大幅增加硬碟管理上的便利性。

BIG : 兩顆硬碟的容量會被加總成一個大儲存容量。

切換RAID設定的標準程序:

步驟1:請在 ST2-B31 連線到電腦後,一併打開電腦和 ST2-B31 的電源開關。

步驟2:請在藍燈恆亮時,將在 ST2-B31 背板上設定 RAID 設定的「切換開闢」調到你所要的設定位置。

步驟3:請使用頂針插入「重置鍵」,待前面板抽取盒上的閃爍藍紫燈結束、並轉成恆亮藍

燈後鬆開頂針。

步驟4:請您再做一次關、開 ST2-B31 電源的動作後,您已經改變、並重新設定了 ST2-B31 的RAID。



硬體安裝

請參照下列步驟,完成 ST2-B31 的硬體安裝:

- 1. 請使用零件包中所附的頂針插入鑰匙孔, 開啟硬碟抽取盒把手便將抽取盒取出。
- 2. 將硬碟安裝到抽取盒上,並以零件包內附的螺絲加以固定,以避免不必要的移動對硬碟造成傷害。



注音:不建議使用不同廠牌,或是同廠牌不同型號的硬碟,避免影響效能。

- 3. 硬碟安裝完成後,請將抽取盒平移放入主機內,並關上把手。
- 4. 透過機體背面的 RAID 切換紐,設定所要使用的 RAID 模式。
- 5. 將相關連接線接上,最後接上電源轉接器。

產品使用注意事項

- 1. 本系統同一時間只可透過一組介面與一台電腦執行資料傳輸。
- 2. 硬碟格式化後,由電腦主機作業系統所辨識 ST2-B31 的實際總容量會與硬碟廠所標示的容量加總後,將有所差異。
- 第一次使用本產品進行設定時,資料會被全數清除。請於硬碟置入前,確認硬碟已備份,避免資料遺失。
- 4. 在安裝新硬碟到 ST2-B31 之前,請先確認硬碟是沒有壞軌而且是沒有故障的,以避免 資料受損。
- 5. 當您需要關閉或移除 ST2-B31 時,務必透過您所操作的作業系統中執行硬碟安全移除 後,方可進行電源關閉的動作。
- 6. 當系統運作時,請勿任意移除任何一顆硬碟,以免導致資料遺失。
- 7. 完成系統初始化安裝後,在使用上請勿任意變更硬碟位置;此動作將可能導致系統無法形成 RAID。
- 8. RAID 模式一旦設定完成,若要進行切換,因切換過程中將會清除硬碟中的資料,請務 必先將硬碟中的資料另行備份後再行切換。
- 9. 為了確保節能功能的正常運作,請將 USB 連接線常態性與電腦端保持連接。
- 10. 當您需要關閉或移除 ST2-B31 時,務必透過您所操作的作業系統中執行硬碟安全移除後,方進行電源關閉的動作。
- 11. 在資料自動重建狀態下,若電腦端進入系統待命或是休眠狀態,ST2-B31 會持續完成 重建;但當重建完成後將不會進入待命狀態。此時需用手動方式關機,或是先將電腦 系統回復到正常運作狀態後,之後才能再與電腦端同步進入待命或是休眠狀態。
- 12. ST2-B31 使用 12V 規格電源轉接器,請勿使用 5V 電源轉接器以免損壞機器及資料。
- 13. 強烈建議除了使用 ST2-B31 的資料儲存功能外,請針對重要資料備份到另一個儲存裝置上或遠端備份,雙重備份您重要的資料。若您儲存在 ST2-B31 的資料損毀或遺失,STARDOM 將不負任何的責任。

After completing hardware installation, turn on the power and follow the instruction of Disk Utility to format the two HDDs, you then could start using your new ST2-B31.



RAID Mode Setting:



- RAID 0: Provide a big storage capacity and the data transfer efficiency, but no data porotection feature.
- RAID 1: Because of this Mirroring feature, your two HDDs/SSDs will keep an identical data after your wtiting works. In case one of the two HDDs/SSDs is defect, ST2-B31 would still work fine with only one of them. And once inserting a good HDD/SSD as the defect replacement, it will do the rebuilding work by itself.
- : With JBOD mode, you could actually use the two HDDs/SSDs as the normal two storages JBOD for your large memory capacity requirement!
- BIG : You could enjoy a double memory capacity from this BIG feature.

The Standard Procedure to Switch RAID Setting:

- Step 1: Please first connect ST2-B31 to your Mac.
- Step 2: Please set RAID Dip Switch to the position you demand.
- Step 3: Please use the Key to press the hidden RESET key at the back-panel, hold and wait for the Blue-Purple LED blinking, and continue to hold it till a stable Blue light comes out
- Step 4: Please turn off your ST2-B31 , and turn it back on again. You now have reset ST2-B31 with a new RAID mode successfully



Hardware Installation

Please follow the steps below to complete the ST2-B31 hardware setup process:

- 1. Use the provided key in the Accessories Kit and inserted it into the Key Access Opening to eject the Removable Drive Tray Latch and extract the Removable Drive Tray.
- 2. Mount your hard drives onto the removable drive tray and secure it with the screws included in the accessory kit to avoid any damage to the hard drive due to accidental movements.



Note: Please avoid using hard disk drives from different manufacturers or different models from the same manufacturer as this may impact system performance

- 3. After installing two HDDs into Trays, please insert them into ST2-B31, and then latch the handle.
- 4. Please set RAID mode at the back-plate of ST2-B31 unit for RAID 1, RAID 0, JBOD, and BIG.
- 5. Please connect the signal cable first, and then power cord later.

Important Notice

- 1. This system can only transfer data to one computer through one interface at a time.
- After the hard disk is formatted, the actual total capacity of the ST2-B31 detected by the computer operating system will vary from the sum of all hard disk capacities stated by the manufacturer.
- 3. All existing data will be deleted when this product is set up for the first time. Please ensure that all data on the hard disk has been backed up before installation to avoid data loss
- 4. Before a new HDD is installed in the ST2-B31, please make sure that there are no bad tracks or defects to avoid data loss.
- If the ST2-B31 needs to be shut down or disconnected, please ensure the HDD is safely removed through your operating system before turning off the power. 6. To prevent data loss, do not remove any of the hard disks while the system is running.
- 7. Once the system has been initialized, do not switch hard disks around during use. Doing so may prevent the RAID from being recognized by the system.
- 8. Once RAID mode has been set up, the switching of hard drives will lead to the removal of data from the hard disks. Please be sure to backup the data on the hard disk before making any switches.
- 9. Please always connect the USB cable to the computer to ensure the energy saving function operating normally.
- 10. If the ST2-B31 needs to be shut down or disconnected, please ensure the HDD is safely removed through your operating system before turning off the power.
- Once the computer turn to "Standby" or "Sleep" mode, ST2-B31 will still complete the rebuilding function. However, it will not change to "Standby" mode after rebuilding. You need to shut down the ST2-B31 manually or wake up the computer to synchronize "Standby" or "Sleep" mode together.
- 12. ST2-B31 uses a 12V/5V AC/DC Adapter. Please do not use other non-certified Power Adapter to avoid damaging to your ST2-B31 unit.
- 13. We strongly recommend backing up important data stored on the ST2-B31 to another storage device or a remote site. STARDOM will not be held liable for the damage or loss of data you stored on the ST2-B31.
